The approximate boundaries of Ghaghgh, Haryana and Punjab are as shown. The boundary between Jammu and Kashmir, Assam and Meghalaya shown on this map are as interpreted from the North-East States Boundary Commission Report dated 1951. The boundary between India and Pakistan is as shown. The vertical lines of latitude shown on this map are as interpreted from the appropriate base line. The approximate boundaries of Andhra Pradesh and Orissa are as shown. The boundary between India and Bangladesh is as shown. District lines are shown in brackets where it differs from the name of the boundary, for example, Telangana.
