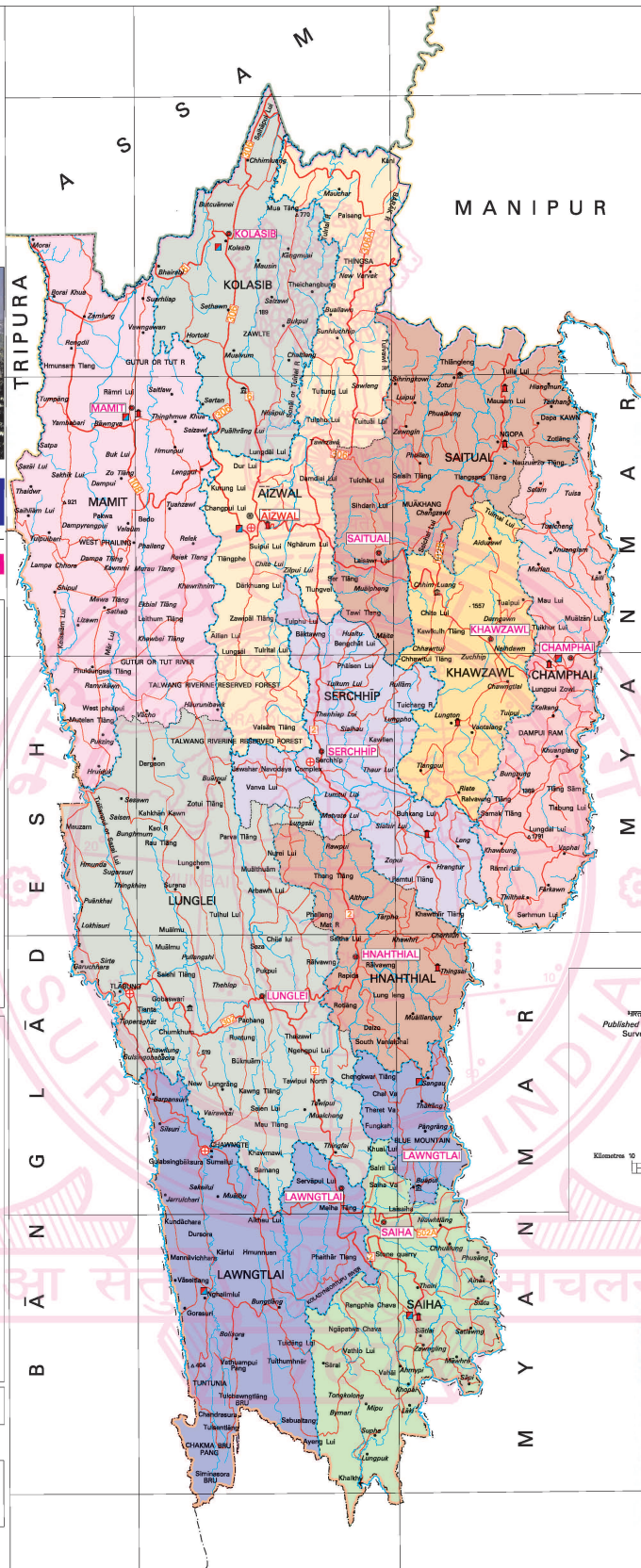

### MIZORAM - An Introduction

Mizoram was previously part of Assam until 1972 when it was carved out as a Union Territory. It became 23<sup>rd</sup> state of India on 20 February 1987. The name Mizoram is derived from Mi (people), Zo (lofty place, such as a hill and Remilundi), and thus Mizoram implies "Land of the hill people". As per 2011 Census, Mizoram's population was 1,09,074 and it is the 2<sup>nd</sup> least populous state of India. It covers an area of approximately 21,057 square kilometers. About 91% of the state is forested. Mizoram is a highly literate agrarian economy, but suffers from shifting cultivation (collected jhum) and poor crop yields. Recently, the jhum farming is being replaced with horticulture and bamboo products industry.

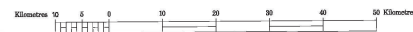
Chimtuipui, also known as Kaledan or Kolodiyu, is the biggest river of Mizoram. It originates in Chin state in Burma and passes through Saitah and Lawngtlai districts in the southern tip of Mizoram and finally goes back to Burma. Vantawng Falls is biggest waterfall in the state and 12<sup>th</sup> highest in the country.

Dampa Tiger Reserve is a splendid Wildlife Sanctuary and located amidst the deep and dense forests of Mizoram. Phawngpui National Park is a gorgeous conservatory forest housing several rare animals and birds. It also includes several species of birds and animals such as the Asiatic black bear and black eagle.
